<p><b><u>When coursework set:</u></b></p> <p>April/May year 10 ('holidays') September year 11 ('work/school')</p>	<p><b><u>When coursework due: (including draft and final copies)</u></b></p> <p>Summer term (June ) year 10 Autumn term (November) year 11</p>
<p><b><u>How many pieces of coursework in total?</u></b></p> <p>2 controlled pieces (plus mini practices to prepare)</p>	<p><b><u>In class or completed at home:</u></b></p> <p>In Class</p>
<p><b><u>Brief description of piece of coursework: (task, length, expectations)</u></b></p> <p>Students are expected to write up to 300 words under controlled conditions. They will have 2 hours preparation time (in lessons), where they are given the task and told to prepare a draft. They will then need to consolidate this draft at home. They will then have 1 hour to write their coursework up in the exam hall with out any supporting material.</p>	<p><b><u>What parents can do to help/support:</u></b></p> <p>Help your child with regular vocabulary tests and ensure that he/she has learnt the relevant phrases in the run up to the coursework. Help them learn their draft</p>
<p><b><u>Percentage of coursework as part of final exam:</u></b></p> <p>30%</p>	<p><b><u>What students need to be able to complete coursework: (resources / books / tools etc)</u></b></p> <p>Students MUST have their exercise books and vocabulary booklets in every lesson. In the 2 hour preparation time students are allowed to use resources such as text books and revision guides.</p>
