<p><u>When coursework set:</u> First Piece: Approximately February 2010. Second Piece: Approximately November 2010.</p> <p>As PE has a new specification starting in September 2009, it is difficult to give an exact date.</p>	<p><u>When coursework due: (including draft and final copies)</u> First Piece should be completed by Easter 2010. Second Piece should be completed by December 2010.</p>
<p><u>How many pieces of coursework in total?</u></p> <p>Two</p>	<p><u>In class or completed at home:</u> Some research at home, but the coursework will be written under controlled conditions in the classroom.</p>
<p><u>Brief description of piece of coursework: (task, length, expectations)</u> Task 1 – Analysing Lifestyle Task. Pupils have to show their understanding of a healthy, balanced and active lifestyle. They will then produce an action plan to improve lifestyle based on their findings. Task 2 – Analysing Performance Task. Pupils will determine the strengths and weaknesses of a performance and then produce an action plan that includes progressive practices to bring about improvement of the identified weaknesses.</p>	<p><u>What parents can do to help/support:</u> Help pupils to gather research for their coursework so that they are fully prepared to write up an excellent piece of coursework under controlled conditions.</p>
<p><u>Percentage of coursework as part of final exam:</u> 10%</p>	<p><u>What students need to be able to complete coursework: (resources / books / tools etc)</u> Research the topics using the internet and textbooks. Gather evidence about the person that they choose to analyse.</p>
