<p><b><u>When coursework set:</u></b> All coursework has now been set and completed in class. There will be opportunities to complete further pieces of coursework, in cases where the current pieces are not up to the students' target level.</p>	<p><b><u>When coursework due: (including draft and final copies)</u></b> All coursework should now have been completed and handed in. Extra pieces will be completed before Christmas.</p>
<p><b><u>How many pieces of coursework in total?</u></b> We must submit 3 pieces of coursework in total, one of which is completed 'in controlled conditions'</p>	<p><b><u>In class or completed at home:</u></b> All coursework has been completed in school</p>
<p><b><u>Brief description of piece of coursework: (task, length, expectations)</u></b> Each piece was 100 words (foundation) or 150 words (higher) and was an essay on a particular topic covered in lesson time.</p>	<p><b><u>What parents can do to help/support:</u></b> As coursework is now complete, parents can help students to prepare their oral exam, which consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Role plays</li> <li>• A 1 minute presentation</li> <li>• General conversation questions</li> </ul> <p>These will be prepared in lesson time, but require a great deal of learning at home. Parents can test their children especially on the pages of sentences required for role-plays, on their 1 minute presentation, and on general conversation.</p>
